

DORM LIFE GUIDE

- Be considerate of people above, below & beside you.
- Your AC is adjustable; let someone know if you need help.
- Some shower knobs are backwards so try both ways.
- Keep your shower curtain inside the shower to NOT flood the floor.
- Beds can be adjusted.
- Don't lock your bedroom door unless you are changing.
- Do not open anyone's door without knocking & getting permission.
- Do not come out of your room without proper clothing on.
- **No guys in girl's hall & no girls in the guy's hall.**
- Only tissue can be flushed down the toilet.
- Anything that is broken or damaged will be charged to that person.
- Don't jump on beds or furniture.
- Keep your rooms straightened; they will be checked daily.
- Leave your room better than you found it.
- **No bullying or pranks.** Help each other!
- There is an RA for girl's and boy's dormitories.
They are here to assist you with **any** problems.
- Building is locked & **alarmed** at night after lights out, opened at 6 AM.

BIBLE Bowl RULES

1. Bible Bowls are a form of Bible competition designed for team play.

The object of this competition is to earn more team points than any other team and, thereby, win the overall competition. Points are earned by winning Bible bowl matches.

2. Bible bowl matches will take place at scheduled times in the worship center.

Points are earned by memorizing and quoting designated verses and scripture blocks to one of your team leaders (see next page), and by reading the required 5 chapters of the book of 1 Peter (up to ten times).

3. In order to win the Bible Bowl, everyone on the team must work together.

No individual can win by himself or herself. The number of teams will be determined by our total attendance. The number of people on each team will vary from one team to another. In order to give all teams an equal chance to win, points will be prorated based on the number of people on your team.

4. During each Bible Bowl session, we will conduct as many matches as possible in the scheduled time.

Two teams will compete at a time throughout the competition. The teams competing will be called to the front of the worship center and sit opposite one another.

When a question is asked, the first person to stand and be recognized will be given the opportunity to answer the question. If a correct response is given, 1 point will be awarded that team. If an incorrect response is given, everyone will be seated and the opposing team will be given an opportunity to answer the question. Once a person is called upon, they will be given 3 seconds to begin their response. The team with the most correct answers at the end of the match will be declared the winner of that match and 10,000 points will be awarded to the winning team.

TriQuest Policies

All adults and students will be expected to follow Christian conduct principles at all times.

1. **Be on time** for all meals and keep orderly lines.
2. **Participants are to be present** for all program sessions and are expected to be on time and in the appointed places when these sessions begin. Should someone become ill any time, he/she should ask the assistance of an adult and go to the nurse. The nurse's location will be in a designated room in the worship center facility.
3. **No one may leave the campus** without permission of the director. No one may leave at any time without an adult team leader. Cars must be parked and locked during the week.
4. **Dorms and grounds** are to be kept clean at all times. Morning dorm clean ups are encouraged. **No one will be allowed to leave campus on Friday until the campus is in order.** If any one caused any damage, then his/her church is responsible to pay for the damage.
5. **TriQuest Ministry Dress Policy:** Attire must be **modest** and appropriate for the Christian atmosphere. The wearing of shorts shorter than mid-thigh, "spaghetti" straps, and shirts with non-Christian printing are inappropriate at all times. **We ask that shorts not be worn after 5:30 P.M. The evening dress is more of a special dress attire.** Remember, the clothes youth bring with them are what they must wear.
6. **Appropriate Swimming Attire:** No Bikinis, ladies please include a colored tshirt in case of a modesty issue.
7. **"Lights Out"** means just that! Our schedule is a full one, with plenty of fellowship during the day. At night it is important that everyone gets the amount of needed rest to make the daytime activities more meaningful. Everyone will clear the campus and be in their dorms at 10:30 PM with lights out at 11:00 PM. **This policy will be enforced!**
8. **Fireworks, firearms or any type of weapon,** of any kind won't be tolerated.
9. **Tobacco in any form,** alcohol or drugs are strictly prohibited. Offenders will be sent home IMMEDIATELY!
10. **No eating or drinking** during worship services.
11. There will be no **display of affection.**

12. **No profanity or negative language** will be tolerated.
13. Due to injuries and other problems, water balloons, water guns, shaving cream fights, or any forms of pranks will not be tolerated.
14. Visitors of the opposite sex are permitted only in designated areas of the dorm.
15. Cell phones that are used outside of the permitted purposes during worship and Bible study times will be taken up. Phone interruptions during worship services and other events will not be tolerated.

1. Bible (with name and address inside)
2. Pencil and notebook
3. Pillow, towels, and bedding
4. Personal items (shampoo, soap, toothbrush, and etc....)
5. Appropriate clothes for daily sessions, recreations and worship
6. Money for concessions and other items of purchase
7. A good cooperative spirit and a desire to hear from God!

WHAT YOU SHOULD NOT HAVE BROUGHT

1. T-shirts and hats featuring alcoholic beverages, rock groups, or inappropriate messages.
2. Any electronics other than cell phone
3. Shorts that are shorter than mid-thigh
4. Alcoholic beverages, tobacco, or drugs
5. Clothes that are revealing and do not meet modesty expectations
6. Fireworks, firearms, matches or lighters
